

Request for Approval of W- and C-Courses Outside the Major

Either two approved Writing-intensive (W) courses OR one approved W course plus one communication-intensive (C) course is required for every baccalaureate degree at Texas A&M University. Acceptable W and C courses almost always carry the prefix of the student's major. Occasionally, a W or C course may be taken in a closely-related field when: (1) there is a sound justification for doing so; and (2) all relevant parties agree. Reasonable justification may include, for example, small majors or majors in which the benefits of interdisciplinary W or C courses are documented.

Your request must be on this form and approved in order for a W or C course outside the major to fulfill the requirement. Please submit this form through the appropriate department head(s), AOC Dean(s), and to the Associate Provost for Undergraduate Studies for approval consideration, who will then send it to the Degree Audit Office.
